Roseburg Senior High School was the first high school in Douglas County to undergo a major renovation and replacement in many years. The Roseburg School Board knew that they would probably only get one opportunity to convince voters of this much needed project as previous bond issue attempts had failed miserably. The District began with an RFP to create a master plan and identify the issues and necessary improvements the campus needed. Paul L. Bentley Architects was hired for this portion of the work. The master plan created and identified the need for better transportation flow of buses, cars, and people. It identified improved security and the ability to shut the campus into lockdown mode and for the possibility of a closed campus. The master plan accomplished these goals, and made beautiful gateway entry points to the campus, as well as establish the need for a “Front Door.” The existing administrative offices were buried deep within the campus and needed to be pulled out for visibility and security.

The master plan was used in many community meetings to show the public what the bond issue would be paying for and was a stunning success raising almost 30 million dollars. The Board then retained my firm to assist in the project management of these projects beginning with the selection of an architect. The firm of DOWA from Portland, Oregon was selected and through the design process made a few changes to the master plan, but kept the basic concepts in tact. The results have been an awesome improvements for staff and students as well as the entire community as the Rose Theatre gets plenty of public use.
