Winston Area Community Partnership, (WACP) raised over \$4,000,000 in the Winston Area to build a new community center. The center was to replace the antiquated senior center which had been part of Winston Community Park for over 50 years. The new facility would be located in the park on property donated by the City of Winston.

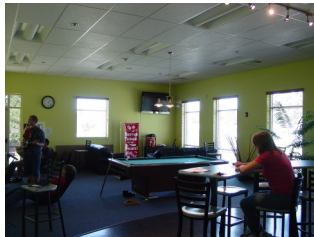
WACP went through an RFP process and selected Paul L. Bentley, Architect over 3 different firms from outside the area. WACP knew that a local firm would be not only be more committed to the project but would take a pride in ownership and was far more accessible.



Library

The project was completed this past year and includes a senior center, library, computer lab, teen center, kitchen for meals on wheels program, community meeting rooms with full banquet services, and a stage for performances.

The exterior of the facility was constructed of concrete block, with a stucco fascia, entry columns and portico. The south facing community meeting rooms have an excellent patio space making the rooms perfect for weddings and other gatherings.
